Books for South Africa

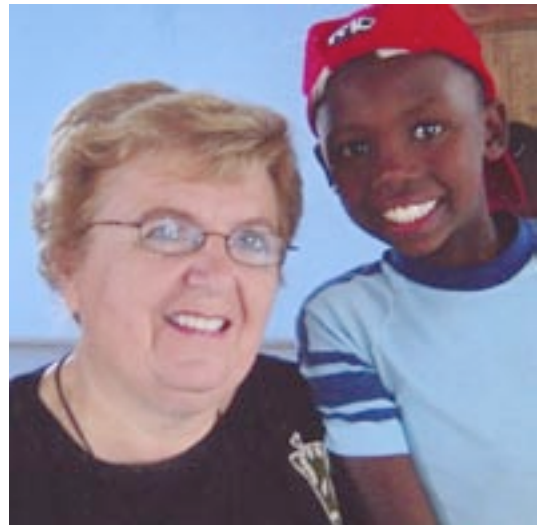
