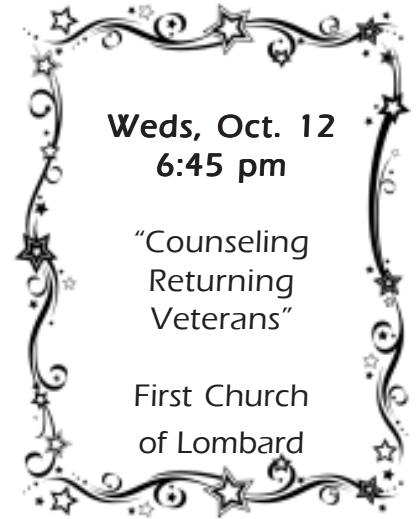

The Board, at its Sept. 19<sup>th</sup> meeting, voted to amend the Operational Budget that had been presented & approved at the Sept. 16<sup>th</sup> Branch meeting. Revisions include:

- ◆ Correction of the "Balance Forward" amount - 1st line.
- ◆ An increase of \$75 in the expected Ways & Means income, to better reflect our plans.
- ◆ Clarification of how Dare to Dream will be partially funded via a transfer of funds (\$219) from the Special Fund, to achieve a total expense of \$500.
